- Complete all unfinished college applications.**
- Two weeks after sending each application, call each school (except UC's and Cal States) to which you applied and check if your application file is "complete," including the correct test scores. If applicable, check to see if the colleges received your Secondary School Reports, transcripts and letters of recommendation. If your application is not complete, follow-up with the right person to see if the document was sent and re-contact the college until you can confirm that all documents have been received.
- Obtain a worksheet for the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) from the College/Career Center. If you are filing the FAFSA online (recommended), obtain a PIN number for you and one parent at [www.pin.ed.gov](http://www.pin.ed.gov).** Do not file before 1/1/10. This form also enables you to apply for Cal Grants. Many private colleges will require that you complete the College Scholarship Service PROFILE along with the FAFSA.
- Write a thank you note to teachers who wrote recommendations.
- Attend the financial aid workshop at Envision Academy.**
